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# Code of Conduct – Concord Youth Soccer League 2010

Players, Parents and or Guardians, in order to participate in Concord Youth Soccer League, you must agree to and sign this Code of Conduct Form. Failure to do so makes child not eligible to participate in the CYS Soccer League.

- 1.) The coach, player, parent or guardian must never place the value of winning over the safety and welfare of players. Winning should be the result of preparation and discipline with emphasis placed on the highest ideals and character traits.
- 2.) Coaches will instruct players to play within the written laws and within the spirit of the game at all times.
- 3.) Coaches will not seek unfair advantage by teaching deliberate unsportsmanlike behavior to players.
- 4.) Coaches should not tolerate inappropriate behavior from players or parents / guardians, regardless of the situation.
- 5.) Coaches should never encourage players to violate CYS registration eligibility rules & policies.
- 6.) Under no circumstances should a coach or parent / guardian authorize or encourage the use of medical or performance enhancing drugs. Players should be directed to seek proper medical attention for injuries and to follow the physician's instructions regarding treatment and recovery. At no time should a player be put at risk by returning from injury prematurely or being forced to play while injured.

## Players Code of Conduct

Players should:

Play the game for the game's sake. Be generous when you win. Be graceful when you lose. Be fair always no matter what the cost. Obey the laws of the game. Work for the good of your team. Accept the decisions of the officials with good grace. Believe in the honesty of your opponents. Conduct yourself with dignity and grace. Do not engage in physical or verbal confrontations with spectators, officials, coaches, or other players. Make sure teammates adhere to the above rules.

## Spectator' Code of Conduct

Spectators should remember:

Children have more need of example than criticism. Make athletic participation a positive experience for the participants as well as others. Accept the decisions of the officials with good grace. Be generous when your team wins. Be graceful when your team loses.

Conduct yourself with honor and dignity. Do not engage in physical or verbal confrontations with spectators, officials, coaches, or players. Never encourage or accept the intentional injury of a player. Support the coach and coaching staff. Never confront a coach. If you have a question of a coach you should contact him or her at a later time.

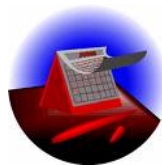

## COACHES' CORNER

### YOU TOO CAN BE A COACH!

There are always openings to coach your child's team. CYS is striving to meet your needs in this exciting area of Soccer.

CYS League strategy is to help:

- #1 Attend the Coaches' Meeting
- #2 Attend one of the referee meetings. You will gain much knowledge.
- #3 Coach Clinic sign-up at the Coaches' meeting. - What for?

### **Coaches' Meeting scheduled July 12 - 6pm.**

You will receive a letter w/location. Why attend?

- A) receive your team packet.
- B) meet fellow coaches /exchange information.
- C) questions answered: Example: "Do I have to play all the kids in various positions?"  
CYS encourages all coaches to rotate the kids in all positions. Remember, the game is for the kids - please don't lose the heart of the child for a win.

FAMOUS QUESTION: "Do I really have to play all kids 3 out of 4 quarters?" CYS rules state: YES-YES-YES. "Even in the Tournament?" CYS rules state: YES-YES-YES.

### **Kindergarten Teams**

CYS will provide a T-shirt and ball. 100% parental involvement required. Coaches: Please plan to attend the Coaches' Meeting. We look forward to meeting you!

## Rules Re-Visited

No sitting AT ALL behind goals - on any fields. Sitting is allowed opposite the team on sidelines - no exceptions. Safety and enjoyment dictate this rule.

Be courteous of others when parking. Signs will be used.

NO Sunday practices/games on any of the CYS Fields.

CYS Soccer DOES follow the Code of Conduct.

Request(s) to be placed with a coach, neighbor, friend, or cousin WILL NOT be honored, due to the past experience of some coaches trying to stack teams.

Siblings in the same division will be placed on the same team unless requested otherwise by the parent.

We base our expense commitments upon the number of applicants we receive, no refunds will be made after May 31, 2010.

Due to the volume of applications, incorrect payment will result in your child being handled as "not registered" until correct payment is received. These applicants will be placed on a waiting list and contacted after teams are formed.

CYS teams may use the fields for practice - be courteous - use half a field so another team may use the other half. It is wise not to "live" in the goal box at practices for continued field quality of goal box during game days.

NO NET climbing AT ALL at anytime on any field.

No parking anywhere near concession stand.

Coaches will not receive their team list until July 12, 2010. Please, no calls before then.

**Shin guards must be size-appropriate.**

## Top Ten Grievances

This list, while not all inclusive, does represent some of the most common misunderstandings which seem to arise from season to season.

- #1 Coaches cannot choose their assistant coach prior to team formation.
- #2 No request to have players put on a special team will be honored.
- #3 If registering late, the late fee must be paid before your child can be assigned to a team.
- #4 There will be no reimbursements for dropping out of the league and uniform must be returned to coach.
- #5 There will be no make-up games. There are guidelines regarding weather - your coach has this information.
- #6 NO SMOKING & NO PETS on the CYS premises AT ALL by anyone. You will be asked to leave.
- #7 If you have any questions regarding playing rules - please ask or see your coach's rule book. Rule Books are sold at concession stand for \$2.00.
- #8 Any spectator disrupting play will be asked to leave the Concord Youth Soccer Fields immediately and/or will be reported and removed by the Elkhart County Sheriff Department.
- #9. Legal uniform rulings. CYS applies the Indiana High School Rules:
  - A. No earrings or body piercings - absolutely no exceptions for new piercings of any kind.
  - B. No barrettes or other jewelry can be worn during games.
  - C. Casts must be wrapped in 1/2 inch foam.
  - D. No baseball or football cleats or front toe studs. You will have to change footwear or cut off toe cleat/toe stud.
- #10. Lastly, decisions made by the referee are final, no allowances will be made. If you have a grievance, please contact CYS League President.
